New Membership Benefit: Sport Accident Policy

During the last 12 months there were multiple inquiries regarding our insurance coverage; a gap that was realized was Injury insurance. Traditionally we have been only getting coverage for Liability. Karate NS discussed this topic and worked with Sports NS to align with what other “combat sports” had for coverage. The Executive and Board voted to add injury coverage for the current cycle without impact the current membership fee process. The new Executive and Board will be task as to whether they want to continue coverage for the next cycle and how they will fund the additional insurance. This cover Karate NS and Member Clubs as the named insured, so this includes all registered members. The Sport Accident policy aligns with the October 15th renewal of the Sport Liability. Appropriate documents will be made available on the Karate NS Membership page after the AGM. The annual rate is \$2 per member, for this transaction it was prorated to be \$1.28 due to the alignment with our other policy.

2020 Membership Registration will soon be underway, and it is important that all forms and registration requirements are sent out in a timely basis. We would like to avoid the large number of late registrations as well as the number of registrations being submitted on improper forms.
